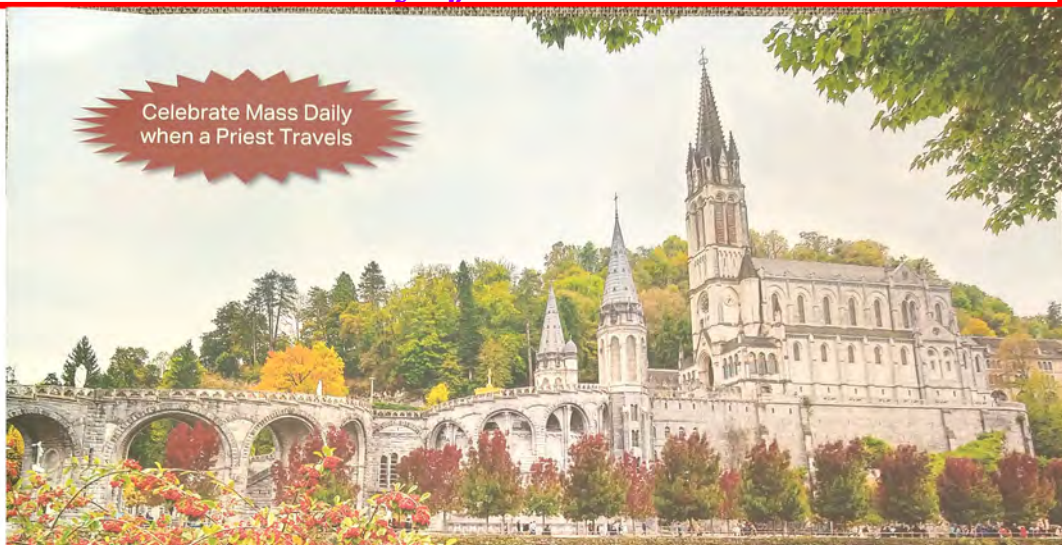

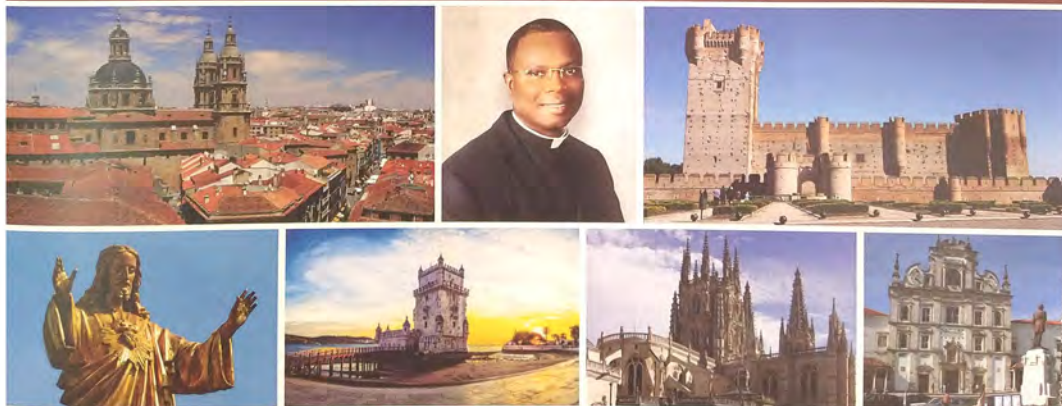

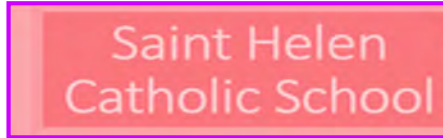

GOD AND THE SALVATION OF THE HUMANKIND

My brothers and sisters, days and weeks follow each other and our march towards Easter becomes more precise. The biblical texts of this Sunday invite us to welcome our Liberating God. It is this good news that we find in the book of Exodus (1st reading). He speaks to us of God who saw the misery of His people reduced to slavery in Egypt; and He calls Moses to release him.

The same God sees the misery of many people today. He sees the misery of the victims of the wars in Ukraine and in many countries. God sees the misery, the injustices, the crimes, the national and international complicities in the fate of the Haitian people. The Catholic Church and faithful people in Nicaragua have been persecuted. God is "Immanuel" which means "God with us". The Word of God tells us that He is with the poor who live in anguish and reduced to misery. He is still with the one who undergoes the domination of the exploiter. God sees it all. The problem is that we miss a lot of suffering without seeing it. In this season of Lent, we are called to open our eyes, our ears and above all our hearts. Our God wants the salvation of all humankind; but he doesn't want to save them without us. He never ceases to call us to work together to build a fairer, more united and more fraternal world.

To enter into this conversion, it is important that we change the way we look and perceive God. Faced with suffering, illnesses, catastrophes, we can have violent reactions. There is a question that often comes up: "What in the Lord did I do to deserve this?" We react as if accidents, tragedies and death were a punishment from God. The misfortunes that befall men and the world do not come from God.

With this Sunday's Gospel, we have Jesus' answer about the Galileans whom Pilate had slaughtered while they were offering a sacrifice. Many think it is a punishment from God. They deduce that if they are spared, it means that they are beyond reproach. Today, Jesus reacts very strongly against this view. He reminds us that the misfortunes that befall the world and men do not come from God. The whole Gospel tells us and repeats to us tirelessly that God is Love. Above all, He is not a heartless vigilante.

But today, Jesus warns us: "If you do not convert, you will all perish in the same way". It is not God who is going to make us perish, it is we who are going to our loss. Since February 22nd, we have entered the season of Lent. The Lord looked forward to this time with greed. His only desire is to enter our hearts and reign there. We are going to allow Him in, by opening the door of our heart to Him. He wants that even more than we do. When men, women and children come back to God, when they rediscover prayer and the sacraments, when they begin to share with the most deprived, Lent is for Him a real moment of happiness. Brothers and sisters, on this day, let us pray together of the Psalm 94: "Today let us not close our hearts, but let us listen to the voice of the Lord. »
